## Application: Surface Preparation

- Surface preparation is critical to a successful outcome longevity of this product.
- Do not apply if temperature is below 10°C or if rain is expected within 24 hours.
- All surfaces to be coated must be clean and dry, free fr wax, oil, grease and other contaminants. High pressure cleaning or treating with suitable cleaning agents for mould, mildew or grease is recommended particularly older surfaces.
- A dry surface is critical for successful and long-lasting finish, 4-7 days is recommended after high pressure cleaning and a minimum of 3 days after standard clean or rain
- Corroded metals should be wire brushed and treated v an anti-corrosive primer.
- All critical areas such as joints, junctions, movement zones, penetrations and drainage points are to be correctly sealed prior to membrane application
- when joint movement is likely reinforcement fabric is recommended.
